Admissions Requirement: Students must be enrolled in an Honours degree program and **must achieve and maintain** a minimum cumulative grade point average of 5.0 (C+) or in accordance with the honours progression requirements.

Students beginning this certificate must have successfully completed ES/ENVS 2009 3.00 or equivalent in their second year of study and prior to completion of 45-60 credits of their undergraduate program in order to apply to the certificate.

Graduating with the Certificate: To be awarded the certificate, students must achieve both a cumulative grade point average of 5.0 (C+) for their degree program and a minimum grade of C+ in each course credited towards the UE certificate in order to graduate with the certificate.

At least 12 credits that satisfy the Urban Ecology certificate requirements must be in addition to those used to satisfy an undergraduate degree.

Certificates will not be conferred until candidates have successfully completed the requirements for their undergraduate degree program.
